This chart shows you the probability of any opponent holding an Ace with a higher kicker, an Ace with the same kicker, an Ace with the same kicker as you, but suited, or a pocket pair. Where the probability is greater than 50%, this area is shaded in green. Of Particular interest, is that if you hold AK pre-flop, someone else, at a 9-handed table is usually ahead of you before the flop.
